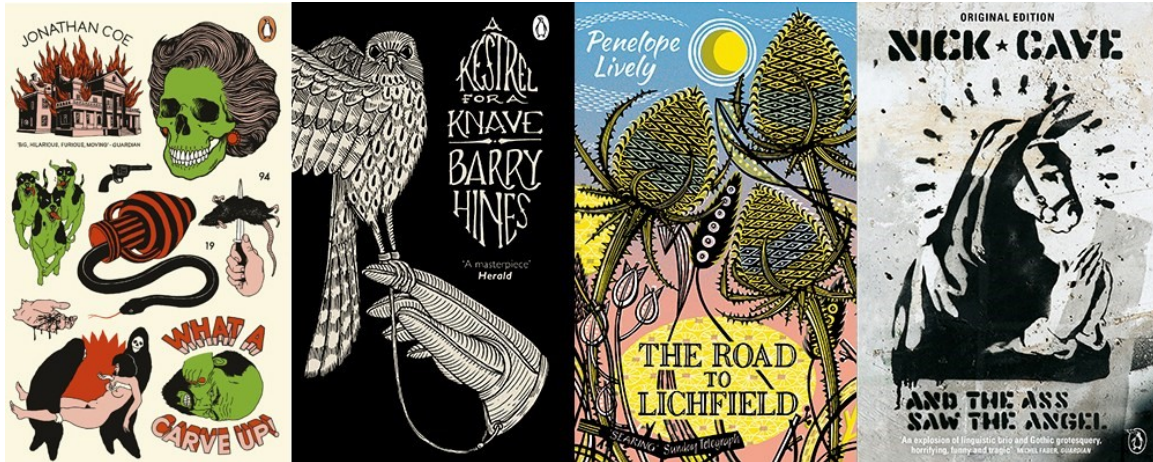
WEDNESDAY 28 FEBRUARY PURIM SPEIL

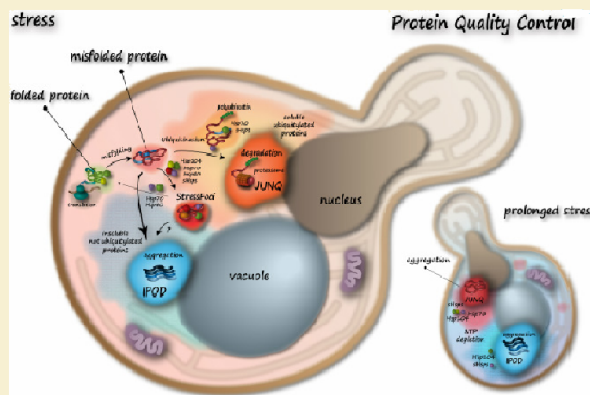

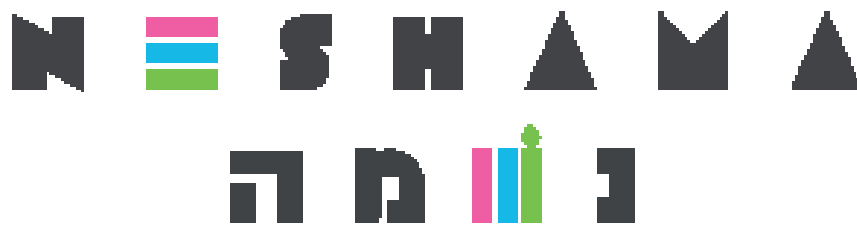
