EALING SYNAGOGUE – PESACH 5778**DELEGATION OF POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR THE SALE OF CHAMETZ**

I, the undersigned, fully empower and authorise Rabbi H Vogel to act in my place and stead, and on my behalf, to sell all *Chametz* possessed by me (knowingly or unknowingly) as defined by the Torah and Rabbinic laws (e.g. *Chametz*, doubt or suspicion of *Chametz* and all *Chametz* mixtures). Also *Chametz* that is unfit for human food and that tends to adhere to a surface of the inside of pans, pots or cooking utensils, and all kinds of live animals or birds that eat *Chametz* or mixture thereof. And to lease all places wherein the *Chametz* owned by me may be stored or found, especially in the premises specified below, and elsewhere, up to and including **Friday 14 Nissan 5778/30th March 2018, at 10:22 a.m.** Rabbi H Vogel has the full right to sell and to lease by transactions as he deems fit and proper and for such time he believes necessary, in accordance with all the detailed terms and forms, as explained in the general Contract of Sale, which will be signed on the instruction of Rabbi H Vogel. This authorisation is made part of that contract. Also, I do hereby give the said Rabbi H Vogel full power and authority to appoint a proxy in his place, with the full power to sell and to lease as provided herein. The above given power is in conformity with all the Torah, Rabbinical regulations and laws, and also in accordance with the laws of the Country. And to this I hereby affix my signature.

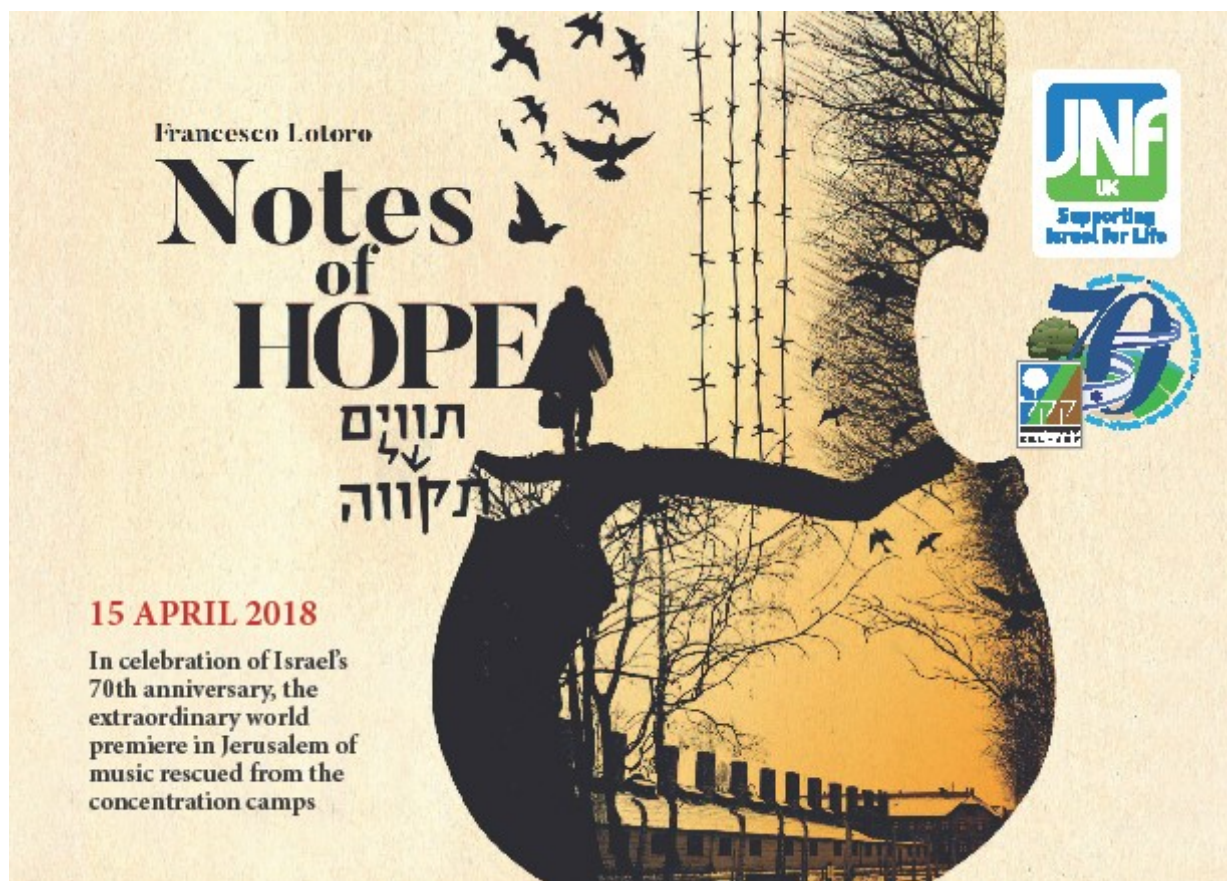

NOTES OF HOPE

The extraordinary world premiere in Jerusalem of music rescued from the concentration camps

Out of the horrors, a joyful musical testament to hope.

Amidst the horrors of the concentration camps of the Holocaust, musicians kept playing and secretly composing. We know from the people and documents that survived, that they composed in the hope that their music would some day be played again.

For more than three decades, maestro Francesco Lotoro scoured the world looking for the hidden manuscripts and memories of the survivors, piecing together this precious musical testimony. The majority of the music is surprisingly joyful, despite the desperate circumstances in which it was composed and the likelihood that it would never be discovered.

In the presence of Mr Benjamin Netanyahu, Prime Minister of the State of Israel, Francesco Lotoro will lead musicians from The Ashdod Symphony Orchestra, alongside a new generation of musicians, including students from music schools in the Negev supported by JNF UK and KKL.

We invite you to witness this extraordinary story of defiance: a tribute to the memory of the murdered 6 million, and a joyous celebration of their hope and belief in the Jewish future.

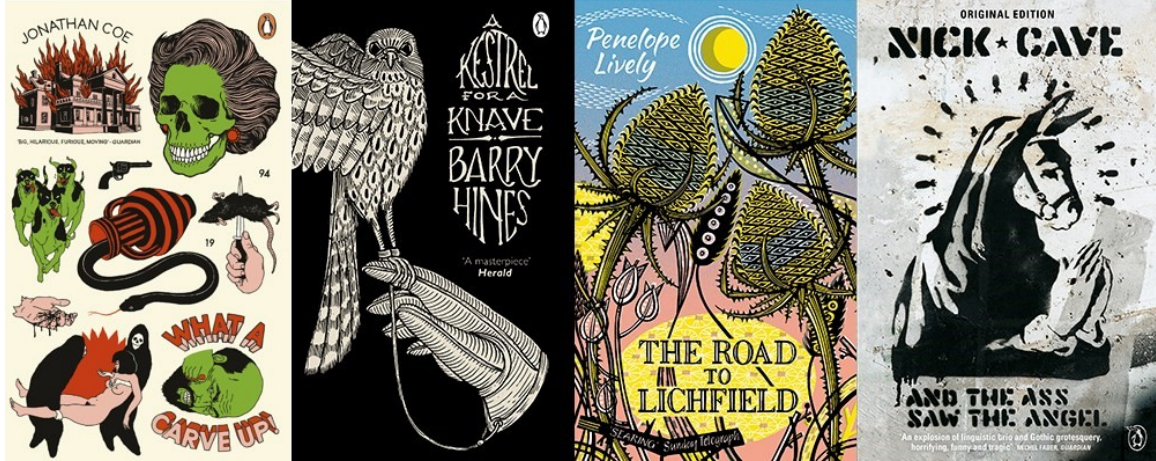
