MIDSUMMER CHARITY JEWISH ARTS FESTIVAL

Following the success of last year's Midsummer Charity Jewish Arts Evening at Pembroke Lodge, Richmond Park, when 200 people came from 4 local synagogues, and £2000 was raised for the Nursery at Nightingale House, this year's Jewish Arts Festival will take place on **Monday 24th June**, upstairs in The Russell Suite, at Pembroke Lodge, which gives more space and time.

The Art Room with Paintings, Pottery, and Stained Glass will open **from 4 pm**. There will be an overall "green" theme, and a cheder competition for A4 Art Posters on a green issue. Teenagers are invited to perform any piece for The Amelie Linsey Music Award.

£20 "All- Inclusive" Tickets secure entry to everything plus a specifically numbered seat for "The Jewish Voice" with Klezmer and Choral Music and Sir Michael Burton's Broadway Hit Songs from 6 - 8.20 pm.

£10 "Promenader" Tickets gain entry to the Art Room, plus the Poetry from 4.30 pm ; and the Eclectic ; plus any spare seat left free for the main concert from 6 – 8.20 pm.

£5 concessions at the door include are for all from 4 pm - 6 pm.

Lady Aurelia Young will be selling her recent book and talking about her father, Oscar Nemon, who escaped from 1930s Germany, and sculpted portraits of Churchill and Freud.

The Times critic Matthew Parris wrote "I attended a marvelous lecture by Aurelia Young on her late father, the sculptor Oscar Nemon, a genius who sculpted the crowned heads of Europe, Sigmund Freud and Winston Churchill."
